Accessing your skills and competences with the ProfilePASS

The ProfilePASS is the most widely used tool for skills assessment in Germany. One of the basic principles underlying the ProfilePASS is the understanding that people acquire many of their skills in informal areas of life. And informal learning plays a key role in development service especially.



Working on the ProfilePASS will enable you to gain an overview of all the knowledge that you have acquired and everything that you have done, so that you can then compile your own skills inventory.
